BRIDGE REPLACEMENT FUNDING PRIORITIES

Eric Landwehr discussed the handout on funding and deficient bridges. We will be removing the bridge on Moniteau Road. Tanner Bridge road is in better shape than shown on the list. Eric stated we need to use up the funding we have available and recommended we replace Old Forge and High Point.

GRAVEL ROAD POLICY REVIEW

Eric Landwehr stated Gravel Road revisions will be for next year 2019.

BUSINESS 50 ST. MARTINS DISCUSSION

Eric Landwehr stated we have in the sales tax budget 4.2 million for major thoroughfares. The county portion goes to Rainbow Drive, but we need to continue into St. Martins to Route T to complete this. Design cost estimate is \$150,360.00 (County \$96,230.00, St. Martins \$54,130.00). Construction cost estimate is \$3,265,000.00 (County \$2,612,500.00, St. Martins \$652,500.00)
