Re: Addendum One to Cole County Bid No. 2018-38: Removal of Underground Storage Tank & Fuel Waste Hauling

The following information hereby becomes part of the above-referenced Request for Bid and shall be fully considered in the preparation of your response.

1. The language in Section 3.1 is amended as follows:

3.1 SCOPE OF WORK. Work will consist of the removal of one (1) underground storage tank and **the blowing and capping of all associated fuel piping lines** as well as fuel waste hauling of approximately 3,200 gallons of diesel fuel. Site shall be backfilled (**last 4" of dirt to be good top soil**) and grass sown. The successful respondent must be familiar with all local, state and/or federal regulations that may affect carrying out the work stated herein and ensure compliance and coordination with any and all applicable agencies including obtaining any required permits, investigating surrounding soil and preparing necessary correspondence and/or reports on behalf of the County.

The site is located in front of the Cole County Courthouse at 301 East High Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. The tank was used to store diesel fuel for a generator, **is 4,000 gallons in size, of unknown size** and constructed of **fiberglass unknown materials**. The tank was capped and taken out of service as of January 2018.

2. Work shall include cutting, capping and pulling lines through the walls of the mechanical room.

3. Work shall include pulling out the internal holding tank in the mechanical room and its proper disposal.

4. This tank is insured through Petroleum Storage Tank Insurance Fund. As such, Section 3.2.4 is amended as follows:

3.2.4 APPROACH AND FEE PROPOSAL. Respondents shall outline how the work will be carried out, outlining key deliverables and associated costs. **Respondents should also address whether or not they will work for what PSTIF is willing to reimburse should soil or water contamination be discovered.** Fee proposal shall include a lump sum total cost which shall be on the last page of the bid response.

The bid receipt date and time HAVE NOT BEEN CHANGED; submissions will be received until Thursday, October 18 at 3:30 p.m. The deadline for questions is Thursday, October 11, 2018.
