### Meeting Minutes

1. Call to order, roll call and determination of a quorum
  - **Don Neumann called meeting to order at 8:01 am**
2. Introduction of members and attendees

3. Adoption of agenda as printed or amended
  - **Don Neumann asked for motion to approve. Jason Gerling motioned, Sam Bushman seconded motion. Agenda approved**
4. Approval of minutes from previous meeting (April 7, 2022)
  - **Don Neumann asked for motion to approve. Frank Underwood motioned, Sam Bushman seconded motion. Meeting minutes approved.**
5. Citizens Request
  - Zion Road – Request for blind driveway sign
    - i. **Eric Landwehr discussed with the Committee the signage request. Public Works recommends to take no action as it does not meet qualifications. Sam Bushman motioned to deny request, Jason Gerling seconded motion. Request denied.**
  - Terra Bella Drive – Request for speed bumps near intersection with Meeting Street
    - i. **Eric Landwehr discussed the signage and speed bumps request. Public Works conducted a traffic study per request. Traffic data is not heavy enough for a 3-Way Stop Sign. Eric Landwehr and staff suggested a**

**double yellow strip mark and white stop bar to the Committee. Don Neumann asked for a motion. Jason Gerling agreed with Public Works and motioned to deny request, Sam Bushman seconded motion. Request denied. The committee agreed with the plan to install the double yellow and stop bar. No action was necessary for that.**

- **Loesch Road – Request for speed study and “Children at Play” signing**
  - i. **Eric Landwehr discussed with the Committee the speed study conducted on Loesch Road. Eric Landwehr suggested to the Committee to deny the “Children at Play” signage and to raise the speed limit in the rural area to 40mph and keep the 30mph in the residential area. Eric Landwehr also suggested to use “Reduce Speed” limit signage. The location for the varying speed limits and signing was shown on the presentation. Don Neumann agreed to raise the speed limit in the rural area to 40mph and keep the 30mph in the residential area. Sam Bushmann motioned to approve Eric Landwerh’s suggestion. Frank Underwood seconded motion. Motion approved.**
- **Old Forge Road – Request for 20 mph speed limit on gravel road**
  - i. **Eric Landwehr discussed and recommended to the Committee to deny the request to reduce the speed limit to 20mph. Don Neumann moved to motion. Frank Underwood motioned, Jason Gerling seconded motion. Request denied.**
