#### **Stormwater Flooding Issues on Homeland Drive**

Eric Landwehr gave a presentation regarding the issue and discussed the concerns that Cole County Public Works has received from citizens on Homeland Drive affected by flooding issues and stormwater drainage problems primarily between Homeland Drive and Pioneer Trail Drive.

Larry Seabaugh expressed his concern that the landscaping and grading above the retaining wall behind the homes on Homeland Drive was improperly done by the contractor building townhomes on Pioneer Trail Drive causing problems for him and his neighbors. Stormwater runoff from the properties is running behind and over the retaining wall and they are concerned about the stability of the wall.

Alan and Sonja Helm added to conversation and stated they were having issues of stormwater flooding during heavy rains around their patio.

Theresa Crames discussed the concern of the neighbors behind her home and negligence of keeping their property cleared which causes the flooding onto her property.

At the end of the discussion Eric Landwehr stated that the county was concerned about the adequacy of an area inlet and swale between the properties. The swale would be the responsibility of the property owners to address but the county would investigate the capacity of an area inlet and would communicate to the property owners of the findings and if an issue was found the county would address it.
