EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION – MANDATORY EVACUATION

WHEREAS, an Declaration of Emergency has been executed pursuant to Chapter 11 of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 11 of the City Code authorizes the Mayor to exercise certain exceptional powers due to an emergency, including the authority to govern the City by proclamation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH Chapter 11 of the City Code I, Carrie Tergin, Mayor, hereby proclaim the following:


1. All areas of the City of Jefferson north of the Missouri River are shall be under an order of mandatory evacuation effective at 5:00 p.m., May 22, 2019, and continuing until lifted by myself or by the City Council.
2. The City Administrator is directed to provide as much public notice of this evacuation order as is deemed possible and appropriate under the circumstances.
3. All law enforcement officials of the City of Jefferson are empowered to enforce the terms of this mandatory evacuation order.
4. Any person who refuses to comply with this evacuation order shall be deemed responsible for any consequent injury to persons or property and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of Jefferson for any damages incurred as a result of noncompliance
5. Any person who refuses to comply with this evacuation order is deemed to have notice that the City of Jefferson may not be able to provide emergency services to persons within the evacuated area and could be held responsible for all costs incurred by the City in providing emergency services that are reasonably related to such person's failure or refusal to comply with this evacuation order.
6. The local emergency management coordinator and other officials or employees of the municipality may assist in implementing this evacuation order or any evacuation order issued pursuant to state or federal authority.
