Cole County Orders in Place – Clarification

Cole County's current Stay at Home Order will expire on April 25, 2020 at 12:01 PM. Cole County would then be under the Governor's Statewide Stay at Home order.

The requirements in Cole County's Establishment Order dated March 19th, pertaining to Restaurants, Bars, Taverns and Clubs are included in Cole County's Stay at Home order. Therefore, this redundant order was rescinded. In addition, requirements for these establishments are in the Governor's statewide Stay at Home order. Starting April 25th, Cole County will follow the requirements of the Governor's Statewide Stay at Home order.
