PRE-BID NOTES

A pre-bid meeting was not held due to COVID-19 concerns. The attached notes replace what normally would be discussed during a pre-bid meeting.

JOB SPECIAL PROVISIONS

Slightly revised JSP F to read as follows:

F. APPROVAL OF CHIP SEAL MIX DESIGN

The contractor shall submit a mix design for the chip seal surfacing capable of meeting MoDOT requirements for chip seal with their bid response. All applicable portions of Sec. 409 submittal requirements shall apply.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Aggregate for the Type 2 Chip Seal Surfacing shall be changed to the following:

1/4" Trap Rock: Grade A2

3/8" Trap Rock: Grade A1

SUMMARY OF QUANTITIES

The length for Lookout Trail has changed and there are several roads added to the list. A new summary of quantities sheet is included in this addendum.

BID PROPOSAL

A Statement of Bidder Qualifications form has been added to the bid proposal and shall be filled out in its' entirety and included with the bid. The Chip Seal Mix design shall be submitted with the bid response. Changes to roads and lengths have been made and are reflected in the quantities shown in the bid proposal

A new bid proposal form is included in this addendum and all bidders shall use the new bid proposal form which is labeled as Addendum 1 in the upper right corner.

Pre-Bid Notes

The following notes replace the normal pre-bid meeting not being held due to COVID-19 concerns:

GENERAL BIDDING INFORMATION

1. Sealed proposals on the forms prepared by the Cole County Department of Public Works will be received by the County Commission, Cole County, Missouri, at the Courthouse Annex, Room 200, Jefferson City, Missouri, until **9:00 a.m., on May 1, 2020**, for the **2020 Chip Seal Program**. The proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud thereafter. Bids received after the specified time for opening will be returned unopened.
2. Prior to the time and date designated for the receipt of bids, bids may be modified or withdrawn only by notice to the County Commission at the place and prior to the time designated for receipt of bids. No bids shall be withdrawn for a period of 90 calendar days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.
3. Plans and specifications may be viewed and downloaded online in the bids section at www.colecounty.org. A hard copy of the plans and specifications will not be provided.
4. **All contractors wishing to bid on this project shall submit the plan holder contact information form found in the specifications to ccpwprojects@colecounty.org prior to the bid opening.** A bid received from a contractor that has not submitted this form will not be opened and therefore not read. It will be returned to the contractor.
5. A bid bond will be required in the amount of 5% of the bid. No personal checks will be accepted.
6. A one-year Performance and Guarantee Bond is required.
7. Questions regarding the plans and specifications will be taken up to 24 hours prior to the date and time of the bid opening. This will allow the County to get the information out to all of the bidders. General questions regarding the bidding process will be answered up to the time of the opening.
8. Addenda may be issued on this project at any time up to 24 hours prior to the bid date and time. It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to verify if any addenda have been issued prior to submitting their bid. The County assumes no liability if a contractor fails to incorporate addenda into their bid. **Addenda will be posted on the website and will NOT be faxed.**
9. Prevailing wage rates are required on this project. The wage rates for Cole County are included in the specifications.
10. The right is reserved by Cole County to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities therein.

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11. Bids shall be submitted on the Proposal Form furnished by the County. All blank spaces shall be filled in on the forms by typewriter or by handwriting in ink. The bidder shall make no other stipulations in the bid form or qualify his bid in any manner. The bids shall be submitted in an opaque sealed envelope marked **"2020 Chip Seal Program – Project No. 2020-502-1, Construction Bid"** and shall be clearly marked with the bid date, bid time and bidder's name and address.
12. The County will accept computer generated spread sheets for the unit price items to help alleviate problems with computation mistakes. If a spread sheet is used, it shall be in the same format as the one included in the proposal. The sheet shall be inserted in front of the one included in the proposal form.
13. If awarded the contract, the Contractor agrees to complete the work by no later than **September 4, 2020**.
14. **Liquidated damages** shall be **\$700.00** per day.
15. Simultaneously with the delivery of the executed contract, the Contractor shall furnish a surety bond in the amount of 100% of the total contract sum, as security for both faithful performance of the contract and for the payment of all persons performing labor on the project under this contract as specified in the contract documents.
16. **Do NOT include federal excise tax or sales and use taxes in the bid prices. This project will be a SALES TAX EXEPMT project. A copy of the federal tax exemption certificate will be furnished.**

The following items were discussed by Eric Landwehr regarding the plans and specifications:

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The County will be providing field inspection.
2. The Notice to Proceed date is July 1, 2020.
3. OSHA safety training requirements apply. The contractor shall provide documentation that each employee has completed the training program and each employee that has not must do so within 60 days of beginning work on the project.
4. The County has the right to overrun or underrun quantities prior to contract award or during the project depending on budget reason.

BID PROPOSAL

1. Bid quantities are listed for each bid item. The Summary of Quantities for each road is shown in Section 9 of the bidding documents.
2. Chip seal quantities are in SY and Traffic Control and Mobilization is per each for each county road.
3. Bid quantities are estimated based on field measurements and are approximate. Payment will be made on actual in-place material. Contractor is welcome to check quantities and if there is a discrepancy we can discuss.

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4. Lines are shown for listing the addendum received.
5. All bidders shall complete the bidder qualification from included with the addendum.
6. Mix design shall be submitted with the bid.

ADDITIONAL DETAILS

1. Most roads have additional area added for radii at intersections and any other areas needing to be included.
2. The required aggregate will be ¼" trap rock.
3. Section 10 has a map for the location of each road.
4. The length of Lookout Trail has changed and the following roads are added to the summary of quantities: Rabbit Run, Rabbit Ridge, Luxury Lane, W. St. Martins Blvd.

GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS

1. Section 109.9.1 describes the requirements for release of the 5% retainage. These requirements must be met before final payment is made.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

1. Technical specifications will consist of the last effective version of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction except as modified in the Bid documents.
2. Modifications to the MoDOT specifications are shown in this section.
3. Range of application rates for the aggregate and oil are shown in this section.
4. CRS-2P oil will be used this year instead of the high float CHFRS-2P oil that has been used in past years.

JOB SPECIAL PROVISIONS

1. The provisions of this section take precedence over any other provisions in the specifications.
2. Please read this section as project specific requirements are detailed.
3. **JSP C – Traffic Control During Construction** – All work shall be in accordance with the latest revision to Chapter 6 of the The Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). Road closures will only be allowed if approved by the County at least 2 days prior to closure. No road closures to be left in place overnight.
4. **JSP F – Approval of Chip Seal Design** – The contractor shall submit a mix design capable of meeting MoDOT requirements for design for chip seal with their bid response. All applicable portions of Sec. 409 submittal requirements shall apply.
5. **JSP G – Stockpile Locations for Type 2 Aggregate** – All locations shall be a paved surface and free of foreign aggregates. The contractor may use the County Maintenance Facility at 5055 Monticello Road.
