COLE COUNTY, MO – As of today, Cole County’s COVID-19 vaccination rate is approximately 40%. COVID-19 vaccines are currently available at least fourteen locations in Cole County.

The Cole County Community Vaccination Site at the Capital Mall offers vaccines on Thursdays. Pfizer and Johnson and Johnson vaccines are available. Register at covidvaccine.mo.gov or walk-in any time between noon and 4 pm. Appointment times are available until 5:40 pm. The community site will offer vaccinations until July 15th.

The Jefferson City Medical Group ([COVID-19 Vaccine Registration | Jefferson City Medical Group \(jcmg.org\)](https://www.jcmg.org)) and retail pharmacies also have vaccine available. Most retail pharmacies (like HyVee, Wal-Mart, and Target) are open every day and do not require an appointment.

All vaccination locations in Missouri can be found on covidvaccine.mo.gov by clicking on “Get a Vaccine” and then “Find a Vaccine”. Enter your zip code to find vaccine locations near you.

The Community Health Center of Central Missouri will be offering vaccines at the United Way mobile food pantry events in June. This week’s events are:
